| HB 2935   | Russ                     | Signed by Governor        | Requires Treasurer's to send delinquent notices out with owners name as shown in Cty Assessment records as of 12-31-current tax year or later   |
| HB 3006   | Peterson                 | Signed by Governor        | The state auditor may uppn request by Commissioners release any surplus funds when sufficient funds in the audit fund have been reserved to pay for audit   |
| SB 481  | Lamb/Nelson, etc         | Failed on the House Floor | Tax commission to prescribe form and list of information requested for an informal or formal hearing  |
| SB 486  | Coffee/McDaniel          | Failed on the House Floor | outside contractors cannot work for commission - only for time spent on the job   |
| SB 1589   | Coffee/Miller            | Sent to Governor          | gave the farm to AT & T (actually all wireless telephone companies) - lowers assessment to 12% on their newly installed service, which at the rate AT&T depreciates property, it will all be new in a couple of years |
| <b>SB 1889</b>  | <b>Stanislawski</b>      | <b>Signed by Governor</b> | <b>This only affects future elected &amp; appointed officials - their choice of contribution rate - anyone running for office should be aware of this new law</b>   |
| SB 2113   | Anderson                 | Signed by Governor        | 300 page bill, some purchasing rules, exempt manufacturing, etc - TXM Mercury Payroll Waiver  |
| SB 2270   | Crain/Sullivan           | Sent to Governor          | transfer on death deed - requirements of designated grantee beneficiary   |

| SB 1323 | Leftwich             | Dead Pursuant to Rules | Changes rule of 90 to 85 for anybody joining system after June 30th, 1992   |
| SB 1591 | Ballenger            | Dead Pursuant to Rules | Shell Bill - clarifies minor language in tax code   |
| SB 1647 | Halligan             | Dead Pursuant to Rules | Value certain tax credit qualified depreciable property brought into the state  |
| SB 1652 | Aldridge             | Dead Pursuant to Rules | County Home Rule Charter Act  |
| SB 1654 | Sweeden              | Dead Pursuant to Rules | Allows cities to create fire districts, financed with ad valorem  |
| SB 1656 | Burrage              | Dead Pursuant to Rules | Deals with how to replace county election board members who have been disqualified  |
| SB 1667 | Wilson               | Dead Pursuant to Rules | county officers would not be able to hire private counsel, only sheriffs in a county with at least 450,000 in population                |
| SB 1690 | Lerblance            | Dead Pursuant to Rules | county officers to run non-partisan   |
| SB 1703 | Schulz               | Dead Pursuant to Rules | repeals certain manufacturers from ad valorem exemption   |
